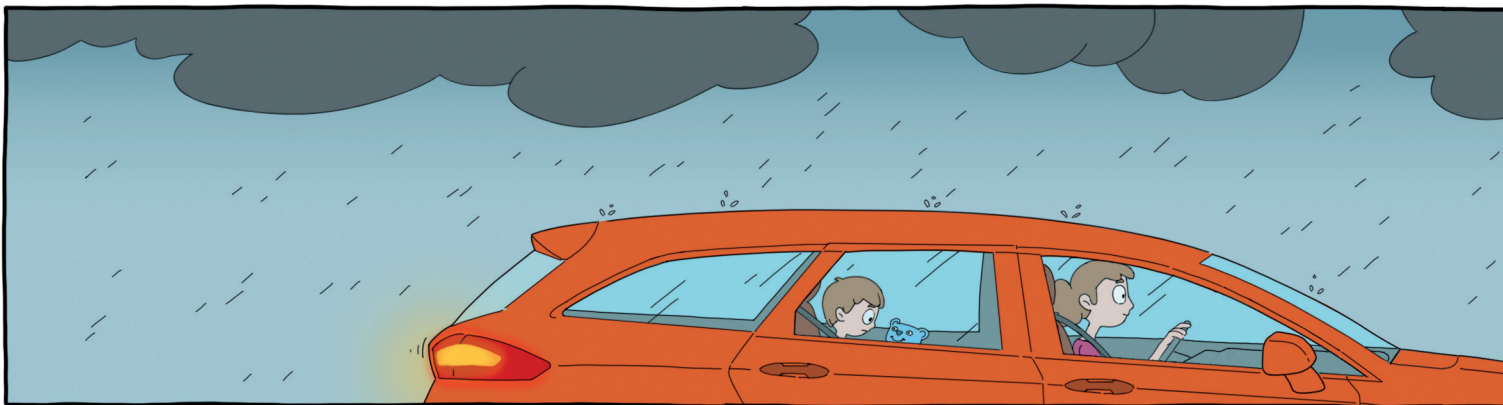
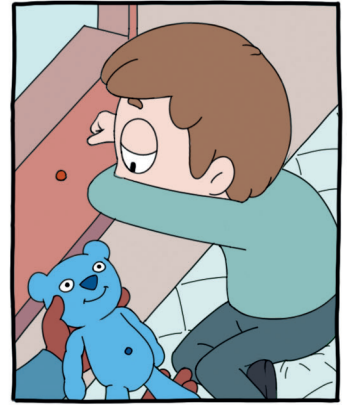
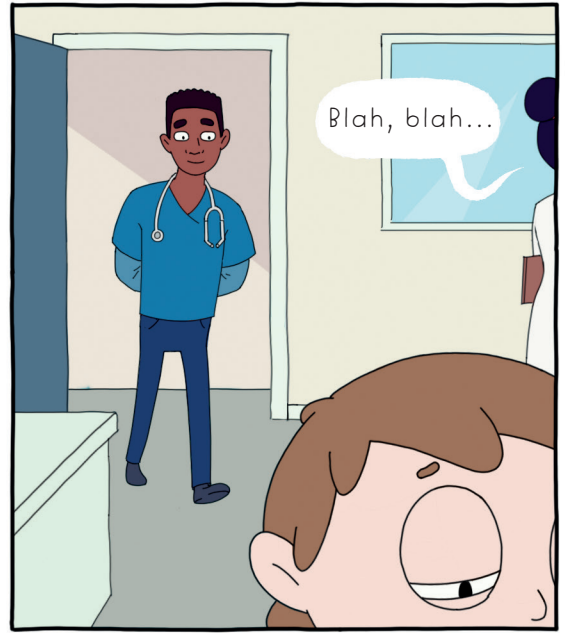


It's a lovely day in Summerville. The sun is shining, birds are singing, children are playing.

IGIII!!



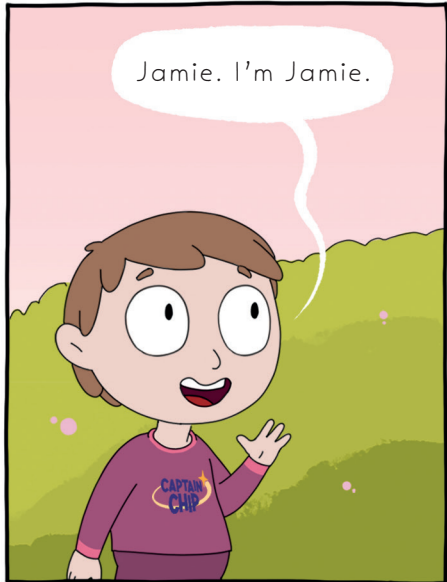
Don't worry. That's just how they say hello.

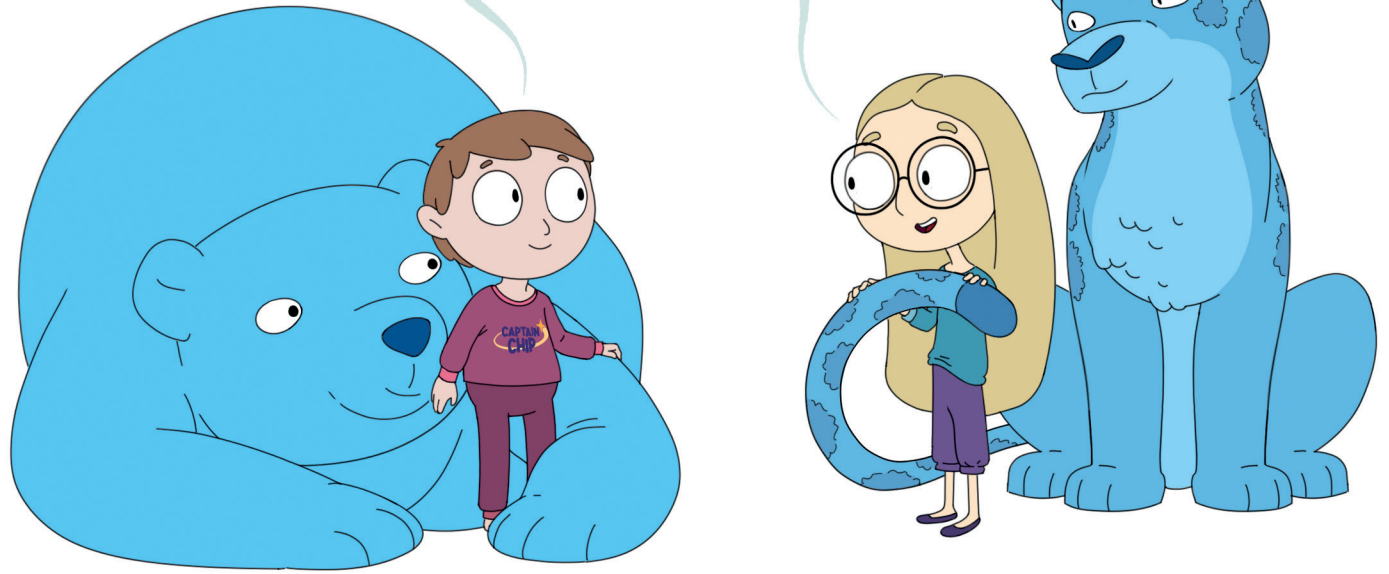

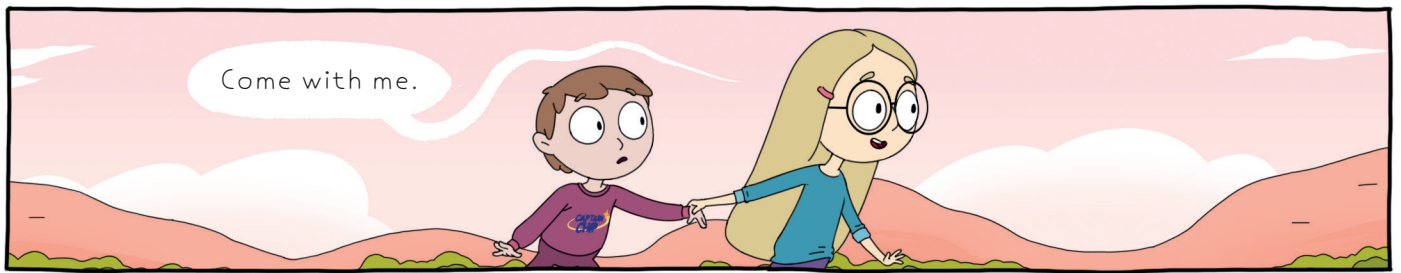

**3** Antibodies are part of your immune system. Their job is to find bad bacteria and call other immune cells to help fight them.

**2** Your immune system protects your body from bad bacteria and viruses.

We eat bacteria.

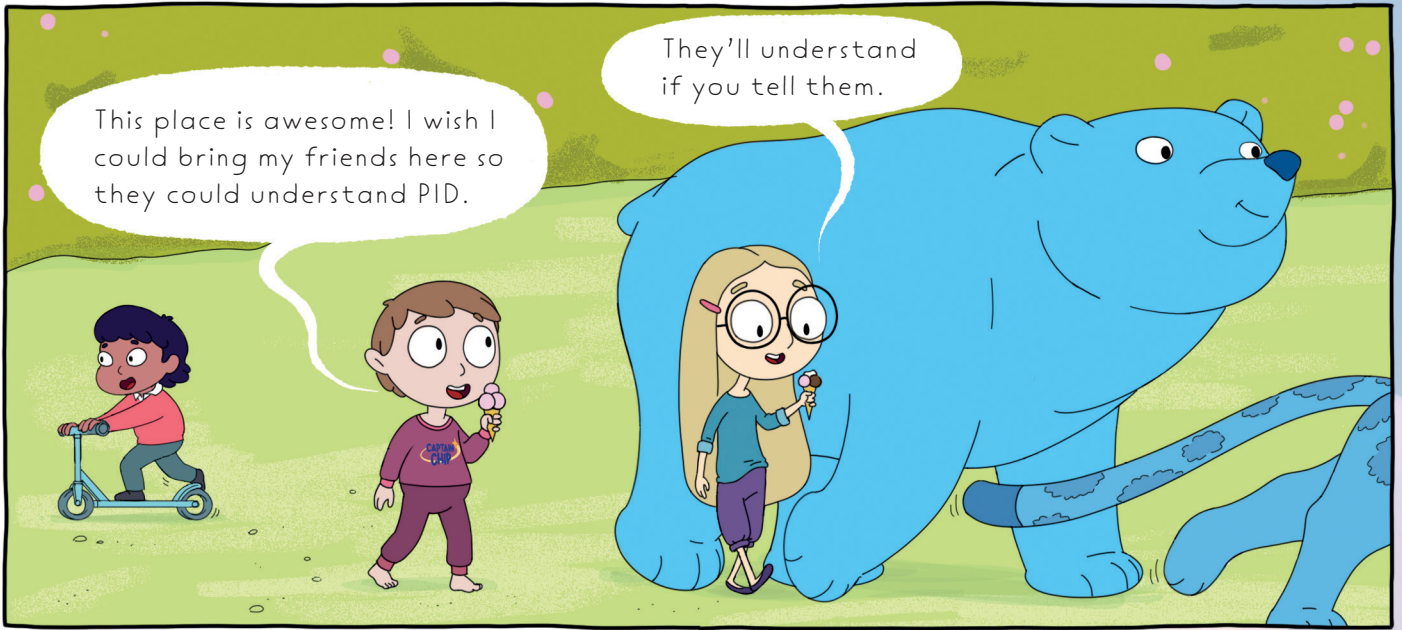
**4** When you have PID, part of your immune system is missing or doesn't work so well. You may not have enough antibodies to protect you against getting infections.

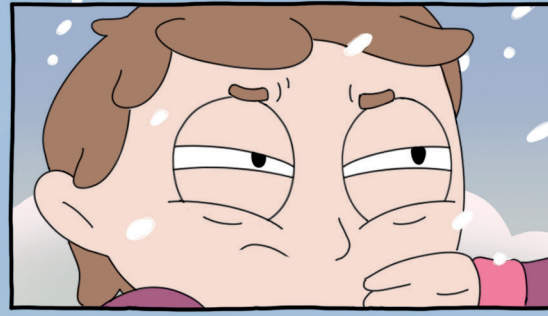
We make you vitamins.

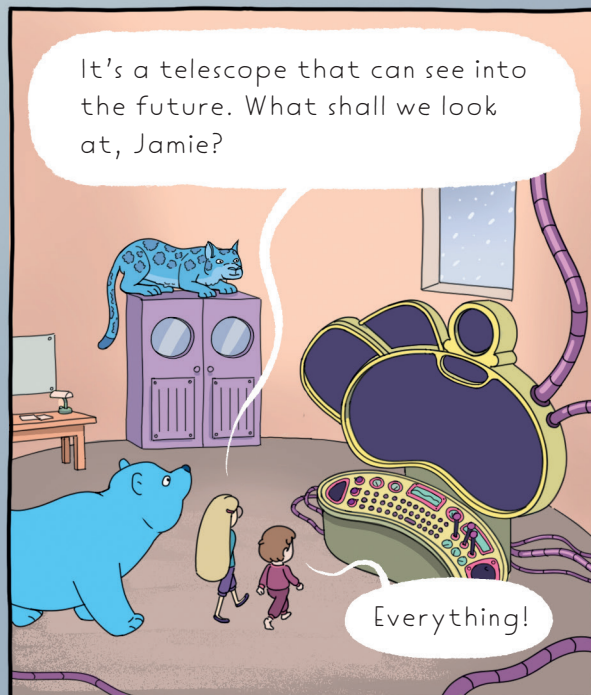
**5** This means you may get sick more often, with chest infections, ear aches or tummy problems.

**6** Immunoglobulin treatment gives you more antibodies - that means more bodyguards to help fight bacteria and to help lower the number of infections that you may get.



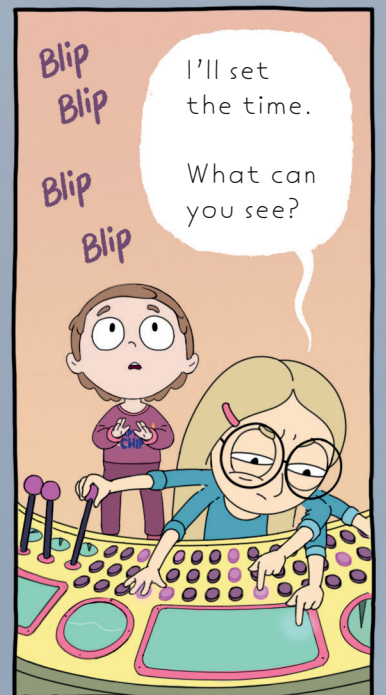

Oh that's the nurse who gave me IGI!

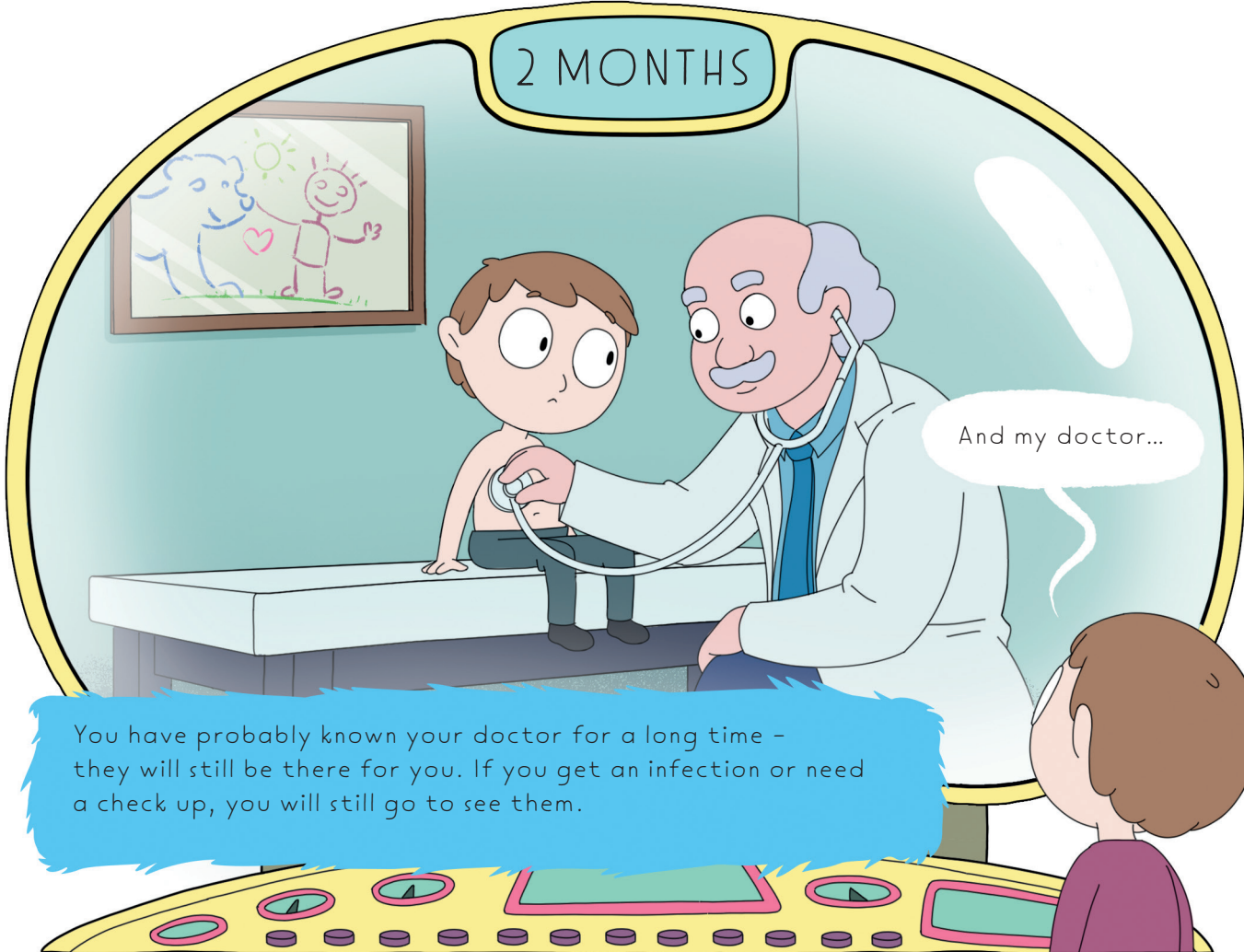

You have IGI and everyone here too!

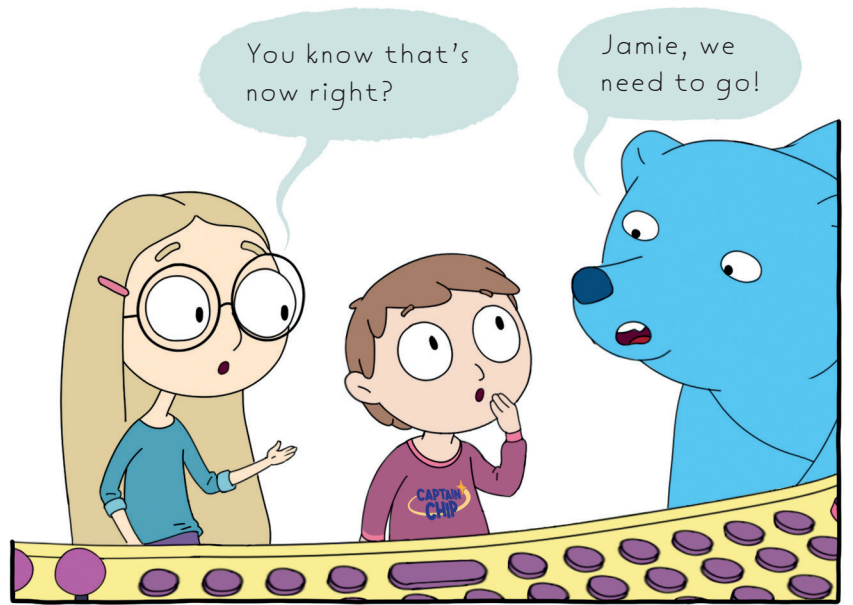
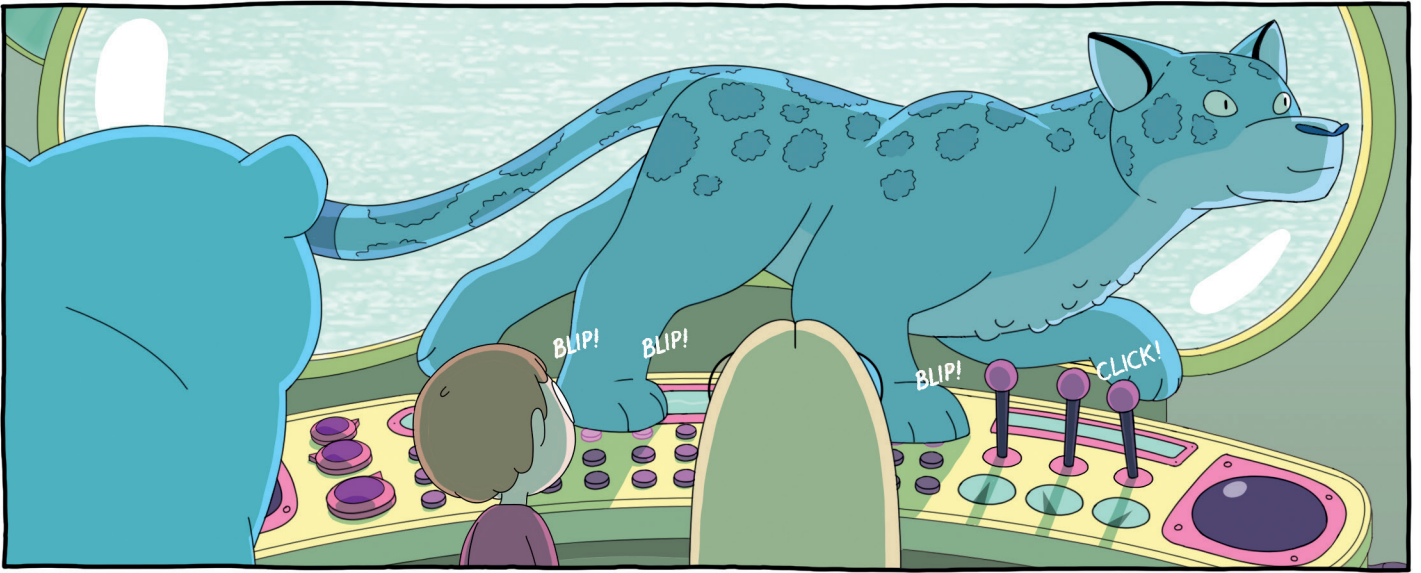
